# Want to Play Some 18 Hole Championship Golf?

Having just moved into Tamarind Grove, Barry Passen was informed that there was not an established league for championship golf for Lakeside Grover residents. Having played in such a league here in The Villages, he thought it would be fun to have something similar for our neighborhood. So, he thought...why don't we start one? If you would be interested

in playing in a neighborhood Championship Golf League, please complete the informational form below and return it to Barry. This league will be set up to have fun, meet your neighbors, and have a little bit of "friendly" handicapped competitive golf on a weekly basis at a Championship course.

Tentatively, here's what Barry is thinking:

- Everyone puts in \$3 each week which pays for the weekly prizes – the "game for that day" plus two closest to the pin on par 3's (front nine and back nine).
- The format will change each week, (i.e. Best two balls, Best three balls, Match Play, Stableford, etc).
- If you have a GHIN handicap, we will use that as a baseline. If you do not have an established handicap, then you will start out as an 18, and your handicaps will be averaged and adjusted

by the League every week.

- Everyone will turn in their scores each week signed by their opponent(s) and we will publish the new handicaps every week.
- You can play whatever tees you wish, and your handicap for that day will be based upon the tee you choose to play.
- Barry will send out an email following the day of play to see who will or will not be playing the following week. (You really have to respond within two days to the email to be entered in the following week. This is necessary so we can have the advance time needed to secure tee time reservations).
- Generally, we can roll the ball in the fairway only. Gimmee putts only if inside the leather and agreed to by all players in your group. No Mulligans.
- Prizes are usually handed out at the 19<sup>th</sup> hole of the course we are playing.....:)

As you probably know, the ability to get multiple tee times for larger groups in The Villages during the "season" can be difficult – particularly if you are a nonpriority member. For that reason, we will probably play local courses outside of The Villages until the "season" ends – and then move back into The Villages



Okay, what would the ruling be on this one? It IS Florida, after all.....

when tee times and prices are more favorable.

That's it. Just a weekly get together to play some golf and have a good time. At the end of the year, we'll probably have a tournament and/or dinner.
