Should tickets run out at the first time slot, members may either return to pick up tickets at another time slot or put their name on a Waiting List. People on the Waiting List will be called if tickets are available after the time slots are concluded.

With all of our seasonal members up north for the summer, we will allow members to also purchase guest tickets for our summer events. Tickets are \$5 per person.

Payment may be made in EXACT CHANGE or by check payable to: Lakeside Grovers Social Club. We will allow members to pick up tickets for fellow members. Tickets **MUST** be paid and picked up prior to the event. **Tickets will NOT be sold at the door.**

Ticket distribution will not occur before the posted time, so please don't ask our volunteers to distribute tickets prior to the time stated below.

4. Play own game or prefer to play best ball?

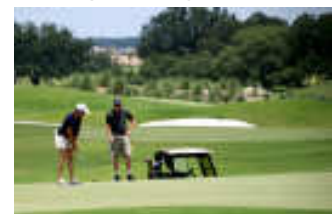
Once information is gathered, Cindy will pick a start date and move forward.
