


What's all the hoopla about our club? Well, those who enjoyed all the fun last

at some of our events, we not only insure that new people won't feel left out, but will encourage everyone to meet people they may not have met before....it's what our club is all about! Not every event is a "mixer", so some events will allow people to choose their own seats. We'll advertise which parties are mixers and which aren't in our newsletter. Let's "mix it up"!

AED Program for Our Neighborhood?

Has anyone in your household had heart problems? Have you ever worried that you or someone you love could have a heart attack and not be reached in time for a satisfactory recover? A group of concerned neighbors and friends are addressing this concern by researching a program called the "AED Program". What's an AED?* An AED is a computerized piece of electronics that ANYONE can use to bring someone suffering a cardiac "event" known as Ventricular Fibrillation, or V-Fib, back to normal cardiac rhythm. (approximately 90% of all heart attacks involve V-Fib) The AED "talks" the operator through everything, step-by-step, from opening the foil bag, removing an electrode, placing it, what to do with the second electrode, etc. Through its electrodes the AED senses the tiny electrical signals from the

heart and KNOWS whether or not the patient is in V-Fib. If it isn't, the AED does nothing. If it detects V-Fib it asks the operator to stand clear and push a button. It is impossible to miss-use one since it will ZAP only if the specific condition it is meant to remedy is present.

What is an AED community?

A group of contiguous residences that have been certified by an appropriate medical professional to qualify. The Villages has dozens of AED communities set up spanning more than four years.

When a residence address inside an AED community makes a 911 call and indicates "not breathing" or "possible heart attack", alerts go out electronically to the cell phones (voice and text messages), land line phones (voice messages only), and emails to all "responders" within that

AED community giving them the address where the 911 call originated.
