Each player's handicap is computed on a weekly basis by the group. It has proven to be very accurate. Handicaps range from 6 to 36 and makes for very competitive weekly rounds. Games and teams change each week from two, three, or four person teams, best ball, or best two or three balls - all with full handicap. Once in awhile a Stableford or scramble is introduced. There are also two closest to the hole contests each week on selected Par 3's. Each week a request is

emailed to the group asking members if they wish to play the following week.

It's a great way to meet neighbors and play some competitive and fun golf.
