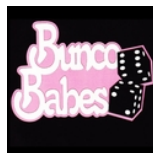

Romeo Breakfast Group

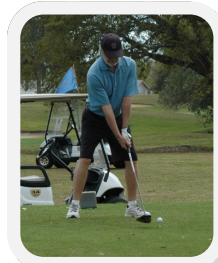

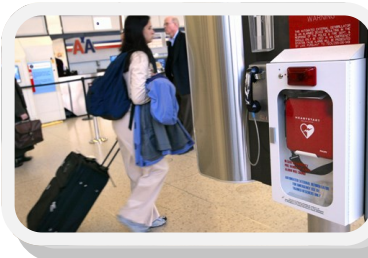
Tamarind Grove 18 Hole Golf Group by Barry Passen

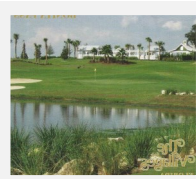
