A change in our regular schedule will allow us to use SeaBreeze Rec Center on **Thursday**, March 23. Entertainment to be revealed at a later date!

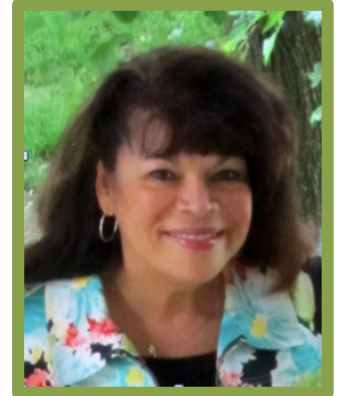
## KAT'S KORNER
