Beginning on March 14, any remaining tickets will be sold to members, nonmembers and guests. To be assured of a tickets to this special event, purchase them this month.

## TICKET POLICY MADE SIMPLE

As you know, we sell ticketless "tickets" to <u>members</u> (including their house guests) at the mail station on the second Tuesday of each month from 4-5pm. We always have a maximum number of tickets we can sell for each event. Once that maximum is met, we will keep a list of names on our waiting list.

If you purchased tickets then determine you cannot attend, contact the person in charge of ticket sales. Her name and contact information is listed in the grey bar on the first page of the newsletter. She will arrange a refund **if you inform us before the refund cutoff date** specified in the *TICKET TUESDAY* section of the newsletter. After that date she will tell you the names of the next person(s) on the waiting list. You are responsible for contacting them to sell your tickets. If she tells you there is no one on the waiting list, you may sell your ticket to any **member** willing to buy it. However you sell your ticket, it is

<u>mandatory</u> that you tell the person in charge of ticket sales the name of person who purchased your ticket so we can update our list. Since we do not issue tickets, the names of the people who will be let into the event **must be on the list.** 

The complete policy regarding ticket sales is outlined on our website in the "About Us" section.

We really do not want to appear insensitive to the difficulties of our members, and we would love to refund your money if you cannot attend regardless of when you tell us, but please understand we cannot give refunds after the cutoff date because this is when we become responsible for the per person costs our vendors charge us. If we refunded money after this date, the Club would have to absorb the loss, and that means we could not continue offering high quality events at low prices.
