




### Lorelei's Simple Instructions for a Patriotic Wreath / Centerpiece

For this 4<sup>th</sup> of July wreath / centerpiece you will need:


- a large wire frame (**Figure 1**) Use a 24" frame if you are doing a wreath; 12" for a centerpiece.
- one roll each (10" x 10 yards) of red, blue and white deco mesh. This mesh is available online at both Papermart and Craft Outlet. You will have enough to do two wreaths.
- craft fuzzy wire (**Figure 2**)
- decorative items, like the flags.



I cut each roll of mesh into 8" pieces. The easiest way I found to do this is to lay the mesh on the table, roll it out a bit, place a ruler on the mesh to hold it down and measure . . . then start cutting. No reason to be exact! Next, you roll each piece and secure the centers with half pieces of the fuzzy wire. (Determine what design you want and start wiring the individual rolled tubes to the frame, alternating between sides and center. (**Figure 3**) I usually twist the back over two wires in the frame for stability. Add your decorative items to your creation. Form a hanger at the top using the fuzzy wire or another type of wire. Enjoy! I made two patriotic wreaths for about \$27, and I have some mesh leftover for another project.
