If you'd like to understand their affect before you vote, come to this presentation by the League of Women Voters on Wednesday, October 17 at 6:00 p.m. at SeaBreeze in the New Smyrna Room. The presenters will explain what a "Yes" and a "No" vote mean.

If you remember the two solar amendments from 2016, you know that the impact of an amendment is not always obvious. This year it may be even harder to make an informed decision because seven (7) of the amendments have multiple issues bundled

into one Yes or No vote. You cannot pick and choose.

If you are not informed, your vote could have the opposite affect of what you intended.

Come to this informative presentation and be prepared to vote on these important amendments. The event is free and you are welcome to bring a friend who isn't a member of the Club – as long as they are a Village resident.
