Come to the September 13, 2022 Ticket Tuesday to buy tickets for the September Event and to pay dues for the coming year. Bring separate checks for event tickets and dues, made out to Lakeside Grovers Social Club. We cannot accept cash.

October 1, 2022 is the start of a new membership year of October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023. Our dues continue to be only \$5 per person. We **encourage payment of dues at the September 13, 2022 Ticket Tuesday,** so the ticket sales volunteers are not so overwhelmed at the October Ticket Tuesday, where they accept checks for the Holiday Party as well as for the October Event. **No one can purchase**

Holiday or New Year's Eve Party tickets until they have paid their dues. Members who join for the first time in September may purchase September Event tickets, without paying the last year's dues, so long as they pay dues for the year starting October 1.


